Concept Note

In the contemporary era of rapid globalization and technological advancement, there is a growing realization of the enduring relevance of India's rich intellectual and cultural heritage. The Two Days National Seminar on "Contribution of Indian Knowledge Tradition to Modern Education and Society with a View to Viksit Bharat 2047" is conceived as an academic platform to critically explore, reinterpret, and integrate the timeless wisdom of Indian Knowledge Traditions (IKT) with modern educational practices and societal development. Indian Knowledge Tradition, rooted in ancient texts, philosophies, sciences, arts, and lived practices, has significantly contributed to holistic learning, ethical living, social harmony, and sustainable development. This seminar aims to highlight how these indigenous knowledge systems can meaningfully contribute to contemporary education, governance, science, technology, health, environment, and social life. Aligning with the national vision of Viksit Bharat 2047, the seminar seeks to examine the role of IKT in shaping an enlightened, self-reliant, inclusive, and value-driven society.

The seminar will bring together academicians, researchers, educationists, policymakers, and practitioners to engage in thoughtful deliberations, exchange ideas, and present research findings on the relevance of Indian Knowledge Systems in the modern context. Through keynote addresses, plenary sessions, paper presentations, and panel discussions, the seminar aspires to foster interdisciplinary dialogue and inspire innovative approaches to education and societal transformation grounded in Indian wisdom.

Objectives of the Seminar

- To bridge the gap between traditional wisdom (Vedas, Upanishads, Shastras) and modern scientific advancements.
- To identify how ancient logic (Nyaya), linguistics (Panini), and mathematics (Vedic Math) can enhance contemporary STEM education and AI.
- To reinforce values of social justice and inclusion through the concept of **Sarvodaya** (the upliftment of all).
- To analyze the role of the National Education Policy 2020 in mainstreaming Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) through credit-based courses and multidisciplinary research.
- To promote "Bhāratīya Drishti" (Indian perspective) in social sciences and humanities, moving away from Eurocentric frameworks to indigenous models of thought.
- To discuss strategies for digitizing and archiving ancient manuscripts using AI and ML to make them accessible for global scientific inquiry.
- To position India as Viswa Guru and Indian values like *Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam* (The World is One Family) as a foundation for global peace, holistic wellness, diplomacy, and environmental ethics.
- To discuss the role of digital repositories and AI in preserving 10,000 years of heritage, ensuring that a "Developed India" remains culturally rooted.

Call for Abstract/Full Paper

Full papers accompanied by a concise abstract are invited on any of the sub-themes outlined here. Participants are kindly requested to submit their abstracts as a word document and PDF both to abcceseminar@gmail.com no later than **March 10, 2026**. Confirmation of abstract acceptance will be communicated via email within one week. The paper should be original & plagiarism free and should not have been published or presented earlier. Authors are required to include the title of the paper, names, designations, affiliating institutions, mailing addresses, contact numbers, and email IDs. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Abstract should contain at least 5 keywords. The abstract should not exceed 300 words, and the full paper, including tables, diagrams, illustrations, references, etc., should be approximately between 3500-5000 words. Manuscripts must be typed in MS Word and PDF both, using Times New Roman font with a font size of 12 (papers in Hindi should be in Kruti Dev 010/Arial Unicode MS). References should be arranged alphabetically and placed at the end of the text in the APA format.



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
How to Reach

Patna is well connected by Air, Rail, and Road. ABC College of Education is located at Neora, Tikiatpur, Patna, conveniently situated directly opposite the Maulana Azad College of Engineering & Technology. For participants traveling by **Air**, the Jayprakash Narayan International Airport (PAT) is approximately 12 km away, with pre-paid taxis and app-based cabs like Rapido/Ola/Uber providing a 45 minutes commute via Phulwari Shariff. Those arriving by **rail** have multiple options: Patna Junction (PNBE) serves as the major long-distance hub about 25 km away, while Danapur Railway Station (DNR) is a more convenient halt just 8 km from the campus; additionally, Neora Local Station (NEO) is located a mere 2 km away for those using passenger train services. If traveling by **Road**, the college is easily accessible via the Danapur-Bihta road; delegates can board any bus or shared auto-rickshaw heading towards Bihta and alight at the Neora stop.
